Laser Cartridges

In order to recycle laser cartridges they are taken apart and then re-manufactured. Remanufactured laser cartridges can cost around a third of the price of an original cartridge.

Re-manufacturing laser cartridges can save a litre of oil and help prevent landfill sites being filled.





Inkjet Cartridges

Many companies will pay a small amount for each used ink cartridge, and many charities collect cartridges as a means of fundraising for a variety of projects. The collected ink cartridges are cleaned, refilled with ink and then sold on again.

Refilled/Compatible Cartridges
